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RESIDENCY POLICY AND DEFINITIONS:

It is the policy of North Central Michigan College to determine a student's residency status when first admitted. A student will maintain that status until that student applies for and is granted a change or moves outside Emmet County.

Residency classifications are as follows:

In-District Residing in Emmet County for at least six months prior to the first day of classes of the semester for which the student plans to register.

Out-District Residing in Michigan for at least six months prior to the first day of classes of the semester for which the student plans to register.

Out-of-State Residing anywhere outside the state of Michigan.

*****IMPORTANT*****

- 1) An approved change in residency status for tuition assessment is not retroactive to any previous semester.
- 2) Copies of all documentation are due along with the completed Application for Residency Change on or before the last day to register of the semester you petition for a change.

Acceptable Documentation (a copy of one of the following must be submitted with the application):

- € Michigan Driver's License: The date of issue on the license must be no less than six months prior to the first day of the semester.
- € Lease Agreement (Your name must be in the lease).
- € Property tax receipt (if you reside in Emmet County).
- € Voter's registration card.
- € Identification card from the Secretary of State Office.
